

The UMBA teaching trailer is intended to provide the extra tools and equipment necessary to teach blacksmithing. Members may reserve the trailer for their own use unless it is needed for UMBA functions. Contact Jim Ribordy to make a reservation.

The trailer weighs 6,000 pounds and requires a 1 ton truck with electric brakes to tow it.

Members are expected to take photos of their event and send them to the editor of the UMBA Journal for publication. Users of the trailer are expected to return it in the condition they found it AND report any problems they might find. Do not leave things from your event in the trailer. If something needs to be added to the trailer's inventory, contact Jim Ribordy.

The trailer's inventory does not include coal, propane, or steel. There are small, random pieces of steel, but no attempt is made to keep an inventory.

This is what you can expect to find in the trailer. Report discrepancies to Jim Ribordy.
